Since joining Second Chance in 1996, Jack has successfully administered the agency's work experience, pre-employment training, housing, and micro-enterprise operations resulting in the placement of over 3,000 men, women and families.

Jack has served as the Chair and Vice Chair of the South Metro One-Stop Career Center's Executive Council, as a member of the City's Social Services and Homeless Taskforces, the San Diego Regional Continuum of Care Council, San Diego Reentry Roundtable, and the San Diego Domestic Violence Council's Solutions to Gender Based Violence.

He is responsible for program development and performance outcomes. Most recently these include; a Department of Labor and Department of Justice Earmark grants, a Department of Labor Youth Offender Initiative grant, a Department of Health and Human Services Capacity Building grant, two Department of Housing and Urban Development sub-grants and a San Diego Housing Commission Transitional Housing grant.

Mr. Micklos has increased the communities awareness of Second Chance and the STRIVE program as a speaker before a Faith Based and Community Initiative prisoner reentry fact finding session, an Employer Forum sponsored by the Prison Industry Authority of the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, and an Employment Training Resource Fair for the San Diego Regional Continuum of Care Council.
