SENATOR CHRISTINE KEHOE TO ADDRESS SECOND CHANCE STRIVE GRADUATION

WHAT: California State Senator Christine Kehoe, of the 39th District, will address the 88th Second Chance STRIVE class at their graduation ceremony celebrating completion of their three-week “tough love” Job Readiness Training Program.

BACKGROUND: Second Chance is a non-profit agency in San Diego established 12 years ago to help the homeless and chronically unemployed with jobs, housing and life skills. Second Chance has developed a national reputation in the field of workforce development, with a focus on the hardest-to-serve unemployed population. It is the only agency in San Diego to operate the nationally-recognized STRIVE job readiness training program, which as seen on “60 Minutes”, has an 80% success rate in helping the chronically unemployed and homeless to secure jobs, affordable housing and family reunification.
