WHERE: Race begins at the Manchester Grand Hyatt Seaport Courtyard in San Diego and will head south along the boardwalk around Embarcadero Park South, continue along the boardwalk through Seaport Village, continue north along the boardwalk near the USS Midway, and then turn around and end near the Manchester Grand Hyatt.
